

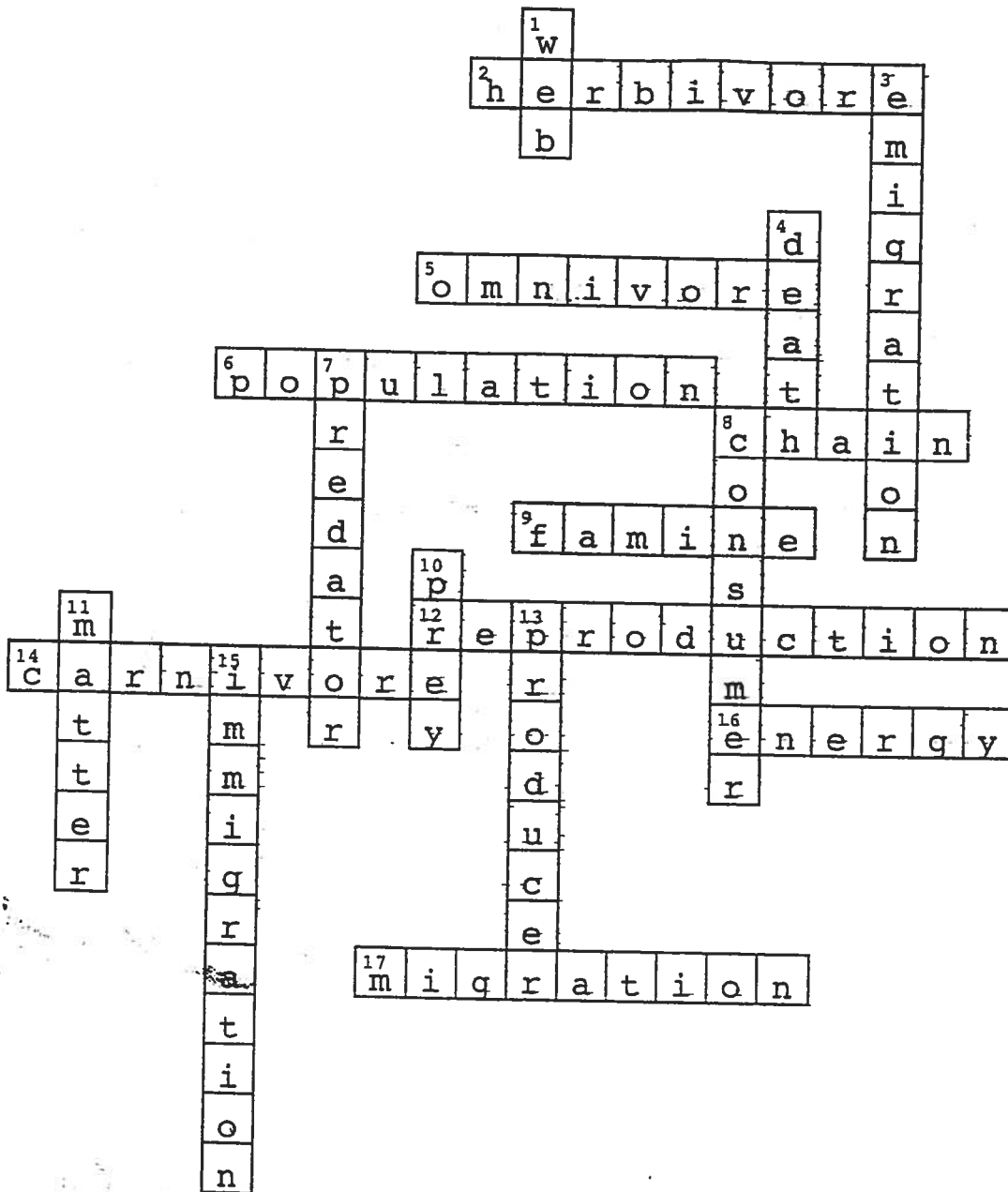

- ✓ 3 Producer: an organism able to make its own food
- ✓ 4 Consumer: an organism that obtains its energy by eating another organism
- ✓ 13 Energy: the ability to do work
- ✓ 14 Matter: a tangible substance that has weight and takes up space
- ✓ 19 Migration: movement of organisms from one place to another
 - ✓ Emigration: migration out of an area (exit)
 - ✓ Immigration: migration into an area
- ✓ 10 Predator: an animal that gets its energy by killing and eating another animal
- ✓ 10 Prey: the hunted and killed animal
- ✓ 15 Population: groups of organisms of the same kind in a given place at a given time
- ✓ 17 Reproduction: the process of creating more organisms of the same species
- ✓ 16 Death: the end of life
- ✓ 18 Famine: a situation where there is not enough food to sustain life

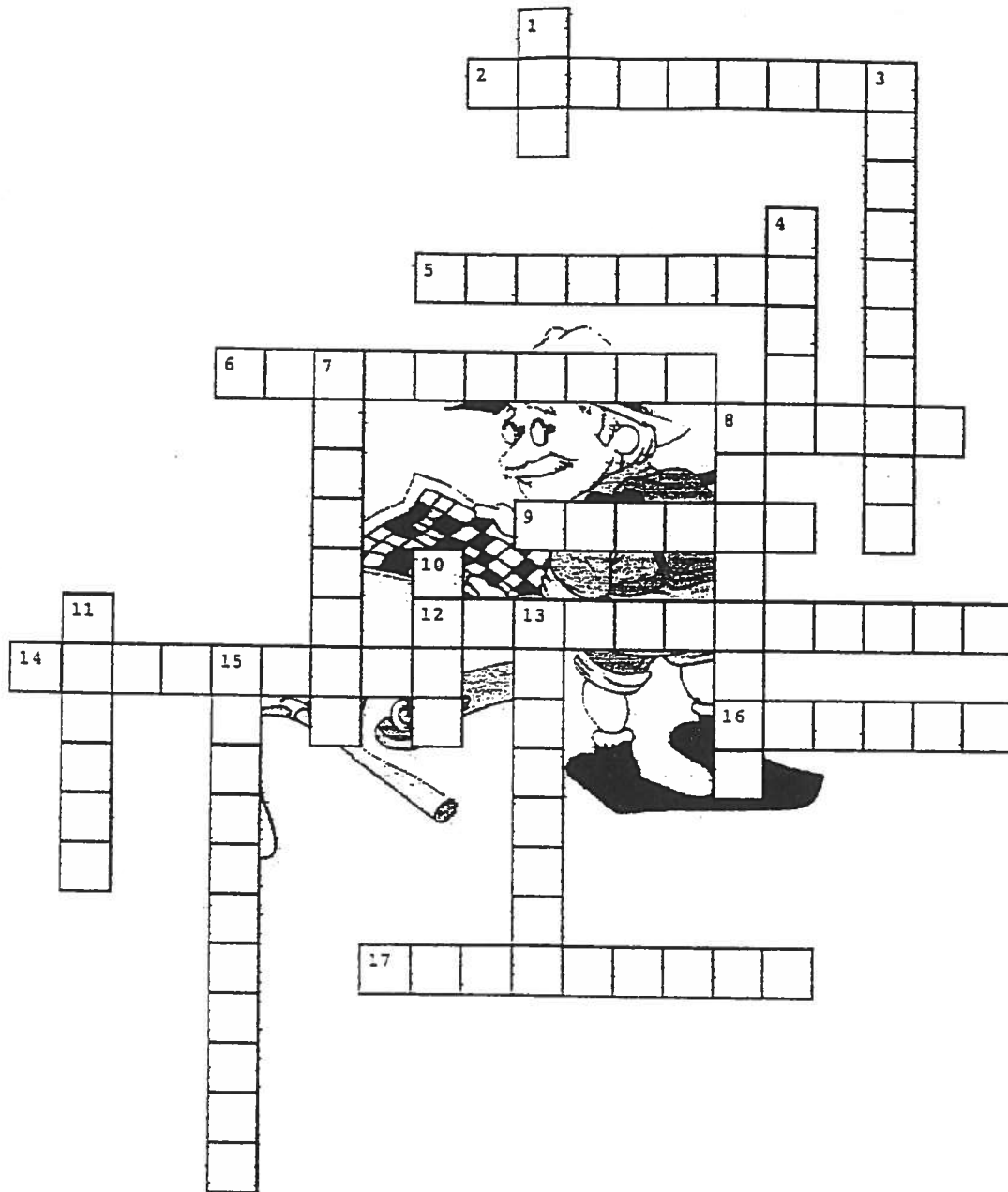
- ✓ 20 Adequate food supply: a situation where there is enough food to sustain life
